Process

- 1. Call or Email to see if you are eligible for Safe Homes.
- 2. If eligible, we will conduct an over-the phone intake conversion.
- 3. A licensed Occupational Therapist will call to schedule an in-home assessment.
- 4. The Occupational Therapist will meet with you to discuss safety recommendations for your home.
- Our Program Coordinator will create your job scope and set up contractors to complete your work.

Eligibility

To qualify for Safe Homes, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be at least 54, or of any age with a diagnosed disability that affects mobility or safety.
- 2. Be income eligible
- 3. Live in Wayne, Ontario or Livingston County
